1. Release Overview

Everest Standard 8.0.8 release is focused on fixing issues reported by customers in previous releases and features to improve product usability.

2. Summary of Issues Fixed

2.1 Issues Fixed in v8.0.8

Following defects are addressed in the release:

- EVCID-10891 Everest Email Incoming email with embedded image (HTML format) does not show the image
 - When Everest Email receives an email in HTML format and the email contains embedded image the Everest incorrectly renders the email and does not show the image. The issue is fixed and now HTML emails rendered correctly.
- EVCID-10887 Everest Email saving HTML email does not save email correctly
 - Everest Email has an option to save received emails. When received email (in HTML format) is saved the resulting file has corrupted data. The issue is fixed and now emails in HTML format correctly saved.
- EVCID-9699 POS return process not working properly (Quantity is not getting carried over)
 - Fixed POS return issue that didn't properly carry Quantity from Return Processing to POS Invoice form. When customer wants to return part of the purchase the qty which is specified for return is not correctly copied to the return document. Manual modification is required. The issue if fixed now and exact qty which is specified for return is copied to return document.
- EVCID-10702 Save button in W2 Form is not enabled



- When W2 form is created for the first time the Save button is not active, it is required for the user to update some data on the form to make it active. The Save button is now enabled for W2 form that wasn't ever saved before.
- EVCID-10709 Inconsistent sound played when trying to commit item with wrong barcode
 - When committing items on the Sales documents and wrong code is specified Everest plays a sound to indicate that the code is not recognized. The volume of the sound is very low. It is now fixed and Everest plays SystemAsterisk sound as configured in the system.

3. Known Issues

- Everest Email when configured via POP3 incorrectly process images embedded into an email
- When email is sent from Everest Email (configured via MAPI) the from field incorrectly setup (e.g. when email is received by recipient the from field will be invalid)

Magento Connector is developed to support integration of the Everest System with <u>Magento</u> <u>eCommerce</u> solution. The integration consists of Magento Connector and Magento add-on. The Connector must be installed on the Everest Server along with the Everest API. Magento extension must be deployed to the Magento system. 5. How to Install or Upgrade to this Release

Everest Standard v8.0.8 can be obtained by creating a Zendesk ticket to either obtain the download credentials or arrange for our Managed Upgrade team to schedule an installation.

Installers were rewritten in v7.1.0 and a clean install is required.

The Everest release uses its own license keys, so appropriate licensing information should be obtained by creating a Zendesk incident ticket before the actual upgrade takes place.
